The principle contractor had been awarded a refurbishment project within the hospital. throughout the working area and provide the hospital with comprehensive digital records of the preventative measures.

The work included preparing technical specification for each of the differing types of service penetration, dependant upon the fire resistance required and the type of service penetrating the fire barrier, be that a wall or ceiling.
